

Family Behavior Policy

At Weaver Child Development Center, we are inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach, which recognizes the environment as the “third teacher.” This philosophy highlights the crucial role of a positive & supportive learning environment in shaping student’s educational experiences.

Staff carefully design the environment to be inviting, stimulating, and reflective of our values. It encourages exploration, creativity, and collaboration, allowing students to learn through observations and interactions with their surroundings within a positive atmosphere.

Parents/Guardians/Volunteers/Relatives/Friends who display inappropriate behavior which may serve to harass, demean or disrespect Staff, Students, Parents/Guardians, Volunteers or which disrupts the positive atmosphere and educational process may be restricted as to their communication with Staff and or may be prohibited from School events.

We expect all Parents/Guardians/Volunteers/Relatives/Friends of the school community to follow these fundamental principles:

- Always respect the caring & positive culture of our school.
- All members of the school community are to be treated with respect and, therefore, we must all set a good example to the children in our own speech and behaviors.
- In this context, ANY threatening, violent or abusive behavior against any member of our school community is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. All members of our community have the right to expect school to be a safe and respectful place in which to work and learn.
- Where the behavior of Parents/Guardians/Volunteers/Relatives/Friends falls below expected standards, the school will take appropriate action which could result in immediate dismissal/withdrawal of the enrolled family/students from the school.
